

United Airlines Hiring Requirements

General Requirements

- Must be at least 23 years of age
- Must possess a current Passport
- Must have a legal right to work in the United States
- Must have a High School diploma or GED equivalent
 - Bachelor's degree from an accredited school is highly preferred
 - All foreign transcripts need to be evaluated for United States equivalency and overall authenticity. If you possess foreign transcripts, you must bring evaluated credentials to your interview.
- Must be able to travel freely within the US and without restriction to all countries United Airlines serves

Certification Requirements

- Unrestricted FAA ATP certificate with airplane multiengine class rating, including the successful completion of the ATP written exam
- Current FAA first-class medical certificate
- Meets *all* FAA airplane category ATP requirements (14 C.F.R. 61.159)
- FCC Restricted Radiotelephone operator's license

Flight Time Requirements

- A minimum of 1,500 hours of total time
- A minimum of 1,000 hours of fixed wing turbine time
- A minimum of 100 hours of complex flight time within the last 12 months

Standard Requirements

- All applicants that are invited to the interview process must be able to provide the appropriate documentation of all flight hours and official college transcripts
- The successful completion of a DOT required pre-employment drug test
- United Airlines background check and TSA fingerprint based on Criminal History Records check
