Lunch With Shaesta Waiz



The girls will enjoy a group lunch featuring Shaesta Waiz, founder and president of Dreams Soar Inc. and the first civilian female pilot from Afghanistan. In 2017, she completed a solo flight around the world to inspire and empower women to pursue STEM-related careers. The route made 30 stops over five continents in 22 countries, taking a total of 145 days. An Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University graduate, Shaesta started the Women's Ambassador Program that in less than three years helped increase enrollment of women from 13 to 22 percent. Since her historic flight ended in October, Shaesta continues to inspire the next generation through outreach events and public speaking engagements. Dreams Soar is building a scholarship program to empower the children who were inspired by Shaesta during her Global Flight for STEM.
